About the Park:

Named after the Southern Red Bishop, this 16 ha nature area lies less than 1 km north of the Rooihuiskraal Historical terrain. It offers tranquillity, cultural history, and abundant wildlife.

Birds you may see:

- Helmeted Guinea-fowl
- Cape Robin-Chat
- African Hoopoe
- Karoo Thrush
- Black-shouldered Kite

Other wildlife (harder to spot): mongoose, porcupine, hares, bushbabies, hedgehogs, reptiles, and a small group of blesbuck.

Vegetation: Bakenveld - open grass areas, indigenous trees, and seasonal wildflowers.

Note: Flat, easy walking conditions. Plus, Minus 2km

Directions:

1. Take the N1 past Midrand, pass the Shell Ultra City.
2. Exit 121A: Old Johannesburg Road.
3. Turn left at the traffic light into Uitsig Drive.
4. Continue, then turn right into Rooihuiskraal Road.
5. Cross the highway, continue past Rooihuiskraal Historical terrain.
6. Turn right into Theuns Van Niekerk Street.
7. Turn left into Roosmaryn Place (cul-de-sac).
8. Bishop Bird Park entrance is at the end of the road.
